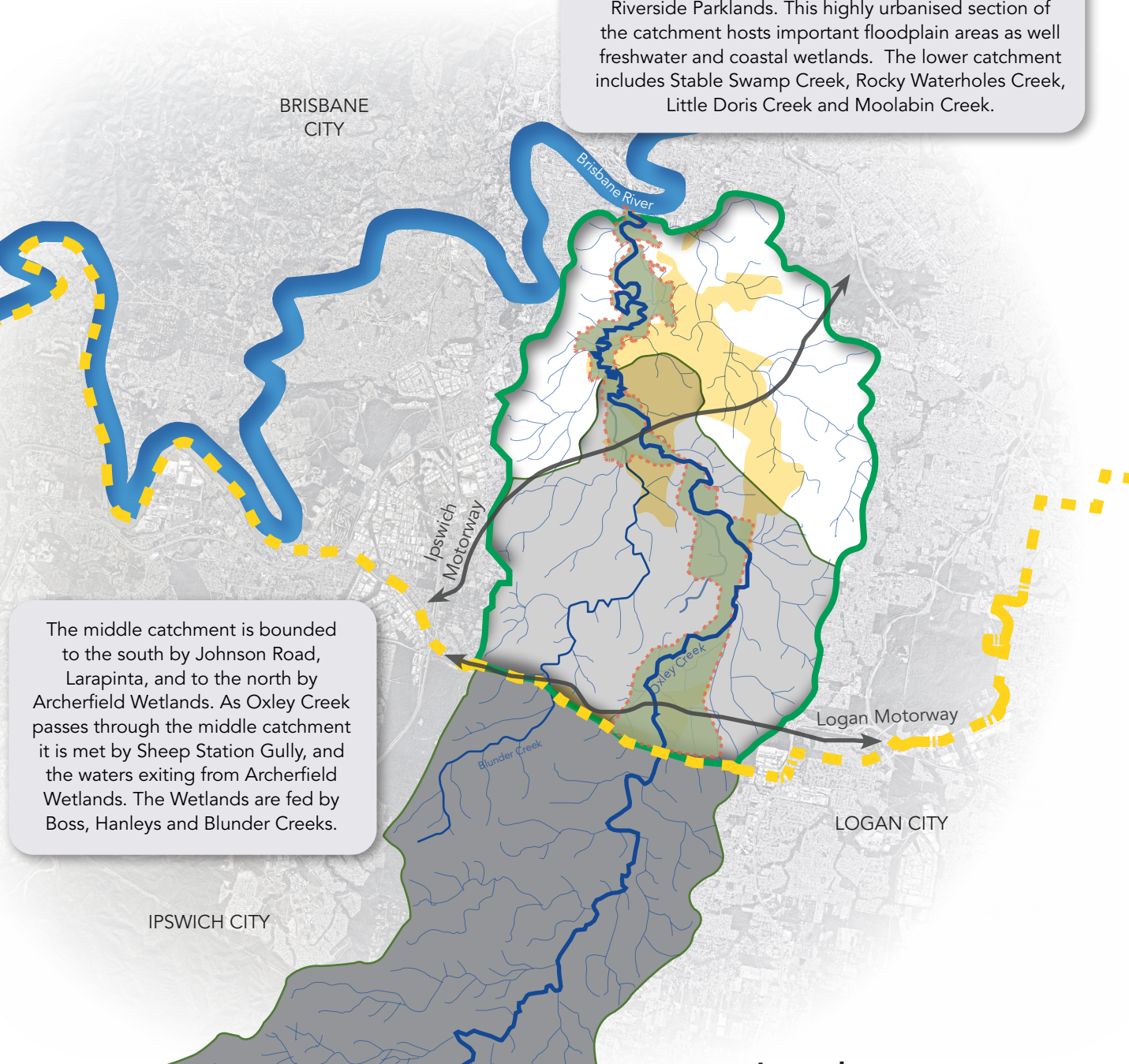


# Oxley Creek Catchment Map








The lower catchment begins around the northern end of Archerfield Wetlands and extends to the creek's confluence with the Brisbane River at Graceville Riverside Parklands. This highly urbanised section of the catchment hosts important floodplain areas as well freshwater and coastal wetlands. The lower catchment includes Stable Swamp Creek, Rocky Waterholes Creek, Little Doris Creek and Moolabin Creek.

The middle catchment is bounded to the south by Johnson Road, Larapinta, and to the north by Archerfield Wetlands. As Oxley Creek passes through the middle catchment it is met by Sheep Station Gully, and the waters exiting from Archerfield Wetlands. The Wetlands are fed by Boss, Hanleys and Blunder Creeks.

The upper catchment of the creek begins in the south at Mount Perry, near Ipswich, and extends to Johnson Road, Larapinta, the local government area boundary between Brisbane and Logan Cities. Crewes Creek is the only tributary of Oxley Creek in this section of the catchment. However, it also includes the upper portion of the Blunder Creek.
