



Sustainable BNE Festival Promotional Terms

Win 1 of 3 Sustainable BNE Festival Packs Promotion Terms & Conditions

1. These terms and conditions set out all the information regarding the Win 1 of 3 Sustainable BNE Festival Packs promotion as part of the 2026 Sustainable BNE Festival. (the Terms and Conditions).
2. The Promoter of the competition is Brisbane Sustainability Agency ACN 099 480 010 of Level 20, 307 Queen St, Brisbane Qld 4000. Telephone number 07 3007 7000 (the Promoter).
3. Information on how to enter this competition forms part of these Terms and Conditions.
4. Competition entry is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
5. Prize: There are three (3) individual prize packs to be won. Each prize is a Sustainable BNE Festival pack from event producers/exhibitors valued at a minimum of \$150. The total prize pool is \$750 minimum.
6. The prize is not exchangeable or transferable and cannot be redeemed for cash. Any additional expenses incurred by prize winners are the responsibility of the prize winners.
7. Unless otherwise expressly stated, the prize value is based upon the recommended retail prices at the time of first publication of these Terms and Conditions. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any change in prize value between publication and redemption.
8. Competition period: This competition will commence on Sunday 24 May 2026 and close on Sunday 7 June 2026 at 5:00pm AEST. No entries submitted after this time will be eligible to win a prize.
9. How to enter: Entrants may enter the competition by completing the official Sustainable BNE Festival survey via the link shared across social media channels and submitting the required details during the competition period.
10. Only one entry per entrant will be accepted, as identified by the entrant's name, email address or phone number, and any subsequent entries from the same entrant may be deemed invalid.
11. Eligibility: To be eligible to enter this competition, a person must:
 - a. fully and correctly complete the official Sustainable BNE Festival survey and submit their details via the survey link during the competition period; and
 - b. not be an employee, contractor or immediate family member of the Promoter.
12. Competition draw: The three (3) winners of the competition will be the first three eligible entries randomly drawn by an officer of the Promoter at 10:00am AEST on Monday 8 June 2026. The decision of that officer will be conclusive, and no correspondence will be entered into.



13. Winner notification: The winners will be notified via phone call or email by an officer of the Promoter within a reasonable time after the draw.
14. Prize claim: Winners must claim the prize via return email or phone call within the period advised by the Promoter. If a prize is not claimed by that date, the originally drawn winner will cease to be the winner and will not be entitled to claim the prize.
15. Re-draw: The Promoter will be entitled to re-draw a new winner and provide a period of time for that new winner to claim the prize. This re-draw process may continue, at the Promoter's discretion, until each prize is claimed.
