Delivery:

- In-school incursions facilitated by sustainability experts from Brisbane Sustainability Agency.
- Sessions are interactive, discussion-based and hands-on, with students working collaboratively.
- Programmes can be delivered to small or large groups of up to approximately 60 students. Session group sizes are flexible and can be discussed and confirmed upon booking to suit class needs and available space.
- Each session runs for 45-60 minutes.





Year 5–6 Program: Creative Thinking for Climate Action

Our Senior Primary School program introduces students to key ideas around climate change, sustainability, and responsible use of resources through engaging and participatory learning experiences. Designed for students in years 5 and 6, the program supports creative thinking while helping students understand how everyday choices connect to larger sustainability outcomes.

What students will learn

- What climate change and sustainability mean in everyday life
- How creative thinking helps solve real-world problems
- How energy, resources, products and waste are connected
- Ways students can take positive action at school, at home and in their community

How it works

- Collaborative idea-building activities
- Interactive demonstrations of climate and energy concepts
- Hands-on exploration of product lifecycles and waste
- Reflection on individual and collective actions

Students will leave with

- A clearer understanding of cause and effect in environmental systems
- Increased confidence in sharing ideas and solutions
- Practical examples of how their choices make a difference

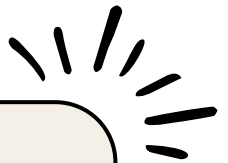

Year 9-10 Program: Sustainability, Systems and Action

This session supports students in Years 9 and 10 to explore sustainability as a complex, real-world issue shaped by values, systems, and choices. The program is designed to build critical thinking, empathy and agency, while helping students understand how individual actions sit within broader social, economic and environmental systems.

What students will learn

- Sustainability as a real-world issue shaped by systems, choices and values
- How environmental, social and economic systems are connected
- Where individual influence sits within larger systems
- Practical pathways for meaningful action without overwhelm

How it works

- Guided discussion and movement-based activities
- Systems thinking and real-world examples
- Exploration of the UN Sustainable Development Goals
- Reflection on taking action, agency, eco-anxiety and hope

Students will leave with

- A realistic understanding of impact and influence
- Improved critical thinking and empathy
- Greater confidence to engage with sustainability challenges
